- > **Objective:** To provide an isolated village with a school for children.

As part of the construction of a road linking the towns of NGaoundere-Touboro-Moundou in Cameroon, DTP Terrassement took part in building a school of 4 classes in NGai-Toukoulou.

In early 2006, the State also provided its support by hiring a school headmaster and three teachers.


With the donation of school supplies and class books conveyed by the site personnel, the school received support throughout the first few months of lessons.

DTP Terrassement also provided materials to the teachers so they could set up in the bush.

The company also set up a contribution system for the parents with the help of Lamido, the Custom Authority.
