### Overview of the Initiative


> **Objective:** to entrust various sub-contracting services (site marking, distribution of information in the neighbourhood, light earthwork, maintenance and surveillance of public lighting networks, etc.) to individuals facing difficulties, with training, recruitment and supervision by district supervisors..., via a regional partnership.


> **Description:**



On 19 March 2008, in the presence of Martin Hirsch, high commissioner of active solidarity against poverty for the government, Gaëtan Desruelles, CEO of ETDE, and the Chairman of CNLRQ, Mr. Lafrechoux signed a national partnership between ETDE and CNLRQ. This partnership includes more than 130 associations which mostly work in sensitive urban areas to encourage social links and social/professional insertion.

Targeted individuals will be integrated in ETDE teams for a 24-month supervised insertion program for sub-contracted services. These individuals will be proposed by local supervisors and may be trained in company trades, and possibly recruited as company personnel. {« According to G. Desruelles *We have extensive geographic presence in France, which coincides with the regional supervision network*»}. This agreement will enable ETDE to strengthen its links and its presence within French towns, particularly sensitive districts, and confirms existing collaboration between ETDE and certain supervision centres, such as Sarcelles (95), Aubervilliers (93), Deuil la Barre (93), Montauban or Bordeaux (33).
