After several prototype tests and satisfaction surveys, new High Visibility workwear is now listed by GIE Purchasing.

Complying with NF EN471 class 1 standard, this workwear has wide fluorescent strips and retroreflecting strips and is designed to fit shoulder and knee protection. For all teams working in the field, this ensures better safety both in the work post and while moving around the worksite.

The fabric is certified Öeko Tex, the label guaranteeing the fabric is non-dangerous and the cotton used in these work clothes is fair trade cotton with the Max Havelaar label.

Designed to improve the visibility of workmates, particularly by crane operators, as well as their comfort, this workwear represent an additional measure to improve worksite safety.

Once again, this innovation demonstrates the company's determination to make continual improvements and to implement every means to reach zero accidents.

This workwear is currently being delivered to worksites for teams of tradesmen and site supervisors.
